A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE WHITEWATER CREEK WATER TRAIL
FOR THE COUNTY OF FAYETTE, GA

WHEREAS, the citizens of Fayette County value the natural resources and outdoor recreation opportunities afforded by Whitewater Creek; and

WHEREAS, the citizens value Whitewater Creek for its water quality and habitat protection; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the County will greatly benefit from the recreational and natural experiences provided by the water trail; and

WHEREAS, providing access to the creek is a desired goal of the County; and

WHEREAS, Fayette County has worked with the Southern Conservation trust to perform a preliminary study to evaluate a water trail along Whitewater Creek; and

WHEREAS, the water trail is consistent with the comprehensive land use plan of Fayette County for recreational facilities for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously supported activities that promote recreation on water resources; and

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Board of Commissioners supports the Southern Conservation Trust working with and educating the citizens of Fayette County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Fayette County, Georgia that Fayette County both affirms and supports the Whitewater Creek Water Trail project, with said project beginning at The Ridge Nature Area located in the City of Fayetteville and ending at Starr's Mill located in Fayette County.
